FAQ'S – CEO GRANTS NEW HAVEN

Q.: Do I need to re-apply for my child's CEO Scholarship?

A.: Yes, families must re-qualify for CEO Scholarships every year, and they may be used at any accredited school in New Haven.

Q.: What is the application deadline?

A.: The application period opens on March 1, 2020 and families are encouraged to apply on March 1 if possible, since the applications are considered on a first-come/first-served basis. Applications will be unavailable once funding for the 2020-21 academic year is reached.

Q: How do I find out the financial and residence requirements to qualify for a CEO Scholarship?

A: The Income Limits and Residence requirements are printed on the CEO website – www.ceoct.org. This information can be found under “Application Information.” Parents or official guardians and their applicants **MUST RESIDE** in Hartford, East Hartford, New Haven or Bridgeport. Families must be at or within 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines for the size of their family. The size of the family must match the number of dependents filed on their 2019 Federal 1040 or other official documents.

Q.: What information is required along with the application?

A.: Each applicant must submit their 2019 FEDERAL 1040 or the application will not be considered. If the family does not file Federal income tax, they must show proof of the source of their income for 2019. Such proof could be Social Security Income or Disability or other official documents.

Q.: If my child received a CEO Scholarship last year, can we be assured of receiving one this year?

A.: Although preference is given to renewals (returning CEO Scholars) and to siblings of renewals, there is no guarantee of a scholarship award. Applicants must re-qualify each year. Early submission of your application to CEO will definitely help a parent receive priority.

Q.: In what order are the CEO Scholarships awarded?

A.: The scholarships are awarded on a first-come/first-served basis, with preference given to renewals and to siblings of renewals. New applications may be approved on a “pending funds” basis.

Q.: What will the tuition rates be at the new All Saints Catholic Academy?

A.: Information on the tuition rates of the new All Saints Catholic Academy may be found on the Tuition Rate Form supplied to the principals of each of the current New Haven Catholic schools. They will distribute the forms to school families.

Q.: What percentage of the tuition is covered by the CEO Scholarship?

A.: The Scholarship cover 50% of the school tuition *up to a maximum* of \$2,100 per academic year.

Q.: To whom do we submit our CEO Scholarship application?

A.: Applications should be submitted electronically at www.ceoct.org. The application will appear no sooner than March 1. Select the Parent Login tab to access the application. Current scholarship recipients should use the email that they used last year to apply to CEO and then create a new password. New applicants should create a new account and password. CEO may be able to help a parent with the email address used last year, however, all passwords from last year have been removed. You must go to “change password” and create a new password. Please be sure to save the email address and password you create as CEO will notify you of the results of your application through your parent account email address.
